In Memorial:

Jerald Brightbill, Tonasket, died at age 97 on February 5, 2024. His 33-year teaching career includes teaching many years at Tonasket Elementary School.

Lois Chavey, Twisp, died February 14, 2024, at age 90. She was known as the "Lunch Lady" at Methow Valley Schools from 1975-1998. She also volunteered for Methow Valley Elementary's Life Skills Program.

Don DeVon, Omak, was 84 when he died on May 1, 2024. As a high school counselor and frequent speaker throughout the Pacific Northwest, Don received the National Indian Education Counselor of the Year award in 2001.

Betty Holmes, Tonasket, died at age 97 on February 5, 2024. Betty taught 34 years including 29 years teaching "K", 1st, and 2nd at Tonasket Elementary School.

Marcia Liebl, Winthrop, died on February 27, 2024 at age 74. Marcia taught lower elementary grades at Winthrop and the Methow School District.

Gerald "Jerry" Mills, Tonasket, died at age 84 on June 4, 2024. Gerald began his 30-year career teaching math and science along with coaching at Tonasket. After several years away, he returned to Tonasket as a Principal and finally, Superintendent of the Tonasket School District.

SCHOLARSHIP TRUSTEE BOARD INFORMATION

The Scholarship Trustee Board is responsible for the scholarship funds composed of three members with one member elected each year to a three-year term rotating by tenure to chair the Board. A new member is elected to serve as chairman during the March general meeting.

The Scholarship Trustee Board is responsible for the invested funds of the OCSRA scholarship account, scholarship fundraising, and determination of the scholarship award amount annually and operates independently of the Unit Treasurer. The Unit Treasurer is an advisor to the Board as a non-voting member and is responsible for the Board's receipts and expenditures. The Scholarship Trustee Board usually meets with our Edward Jones Advisor once or twice a year to help determine the amount of the scholarship(s) to be awarded in May. We have one Board member leaving our Board this coming year; if you would like to be part of this group, we would love to have you join us. A History of Giving Helen Keller stated, "Alone we can do so little; together we can do so much." Look at what OCSRA has achieved by working together and pooling our dues: Since the fall of 2006, OCSRA has awarded 135 school grants totaling \$22,200 and issued 15 college scholarships totaling \$15,000. In 2011, OCSRA added Community Service work such as donating Items to Okanogan County military personnel serving overseas, area food banks, and the Support Center, and providing \$10,300 to help community projects. Working together, OCSRA has made an amazing history of giving to our schools and communities.

<u>Membership Matters</u>: You may ask, "What do I get for \$7 per month?" Actually WSSRA receives \$5 and OCSRA receives \$2. Washington State School Retirees Association works year-round to protect and enhance pensions for all current and retired school employees. The Olympia office employs an executive director, legislative director, two contract lobbyists, and support staff

to aid in this effort. Dues from both organizations support scholarships for future educators. Insurance and travel opportunities are available to both active and retiree members through AMBA (Association Member Benefits Advisors). Active OCSRA members may apply for grants to purchase classroom materials. Refer to the application included in this newsletter. All districts in Okanogan County have received grants with Okanogan School District leading the way with 64 grants totaling \$9,700.

GRANTS AVAILABLE FOR OCSRA MEMBERS

ATTENTION: <u>Members</u> of Okanogan County School Retirees' Association (OCSRA) currently employed or volunteering in one of the Association's school districts—

OCSRA offers <u>members</u> eight \$300 grants this school year. The grant must be used in a single school year to fund projects and materials (excluding field trips) not covered by other financial means. The grants must be used in an OCSRA School District and the application must have the signature of the *building principal*. This year four grants will be awarded in the fall with an October 15 deadline and four grants will be awarded in the spring with a February 15 deadline.
