2024 Elementary School Mini-Grants FAQ

Purpose: To provide an opportunity for public school employees to acquire materials or provide experiences for their students above and beyond what is paid for by district funds. The materials or experiences should supplement and enhance building or district goals.

TCSRA members are eligible for awards of up to \$400. Non-members are eligible for awards of up to \$200.
